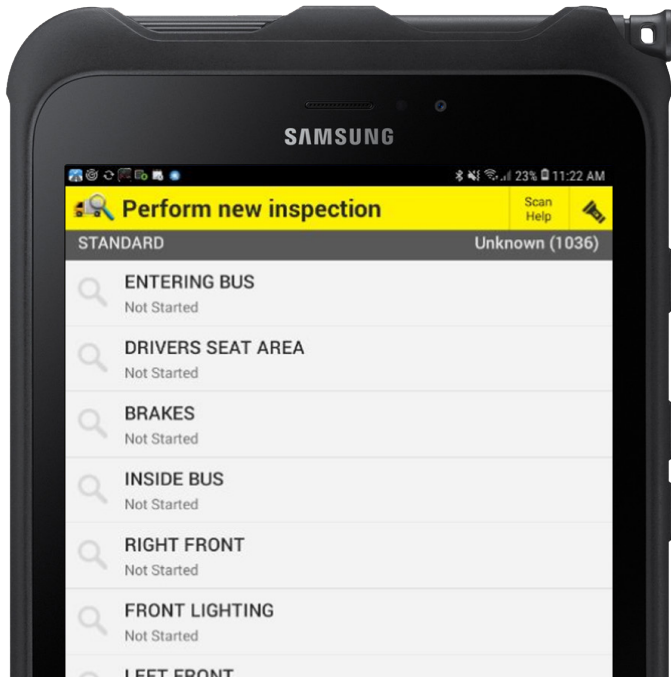

- Place a Zonar RFID or NFC tag on each inspection zone of the vehicle.
- Drivers must physically visit each sanitization zone and scan the tag.
- Drivers electronically sign the inspection and upload the results into our secure online portal.

Fleet managers can log in to the online portal to monitor completed, incomplete or missing sanitization checks. They can also view the timestamped zones to see if any part of the cleaning was rushed or performed improperly.

1. Scan asset tag.
2. Scan zone tags.
 - Entrance
 - Driver area
 - Inside bus
3. Check components.
 - Handrails
 - Seats
 - Steps
 - Floor
 - Steering wheel and seat belts
 - Mirror and windshield
 - Dash and switches
 - Empty waste basket
